⁵ Spending on the AC, SMART and TEACH Grants is mandatory, and left largely unaddressed by the decisions of appropriations committees, much like federal student loan programs. Each of these programs will be operated in such a way that any applicant that satisfies the programs' requirements will receive the aid for which they are eligible.

⁶ The College Access and Completion Fund is a time-limited, mandatory program that would provide \$2.5 billion over 5 years in flexible grants to State or national entities.

⁷ The President's FY2010 Budget Request would convert Pell Grants to a mandatory spending program.
